A CRUISE ON UCLA's *R/V Sea World*

Four half-day cruises on the *Sea World*, a small oceanographic research vessel operated by UCLA, have been scheduled this quarter on November 2 and 4. The *Sea World* will leave from a dock at Marina del Rey and bus transportation will be provided from UCLA. The cruises are planned for the following dates and times:

How to get on the cruise.

We are limited to 36 students per cruise. This is the capacity for the *Sea World* and cannot be exceeded. Thus, we are only able to accommodate 144 students (about 1/3 of the class) with the presently scheduled cruises. Students must make a deposit of \$20 to reserve their spot on the cruise. This deposit is necessary to be certain that students are committed to attending the field trip. Only sign up for one trip. Those found to have signed up for multiple cruises will be dropped from all cruise lists.

Make out a \$20 check, made payable to UC Regents. This deposit will be refunded to everyone who attends the cruise. Additionally, if you are not selected for the final cruise, your check will be returned to you. Students who miss the cruise will 1) forfeit their \$20 check and 2) have one point of extra credit subtracted from their final course grade.

Checks will be accepted on a first come first serve basis starting after lecture as of Tuesday, February 7th. The cruise lists will be posted outside the Oceanography lab within a day of so of the 7th.
